I am requesting funding for purchasing Guam Police Department 20 Patrol Vehicles in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Guam Police Department, located in Tiyan/Barrigada at Building 13-16A Mariner Avenue, 96913. The funding would be used for purchasing 20 patrol cars and accompanying radio communications systems. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because IT aims to address the critical need for acquiring marked police patrol vehicles to strengthen the GPD's response capabilities and overall public safety efforts. By augmenting its marked vehicle fleet, the GPD will ensure a more reliable and efficient response to daily safety and emergency incidents, mitigating potential shortcomings and enhancing community safety.
